

STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE PACKAGING AND PACKAGING WASTE REGULATION

Culimeta Baltics SIA hereby confirms that the packaging used for the storage, order preparation and delivery of glass fibre products is assessed taking into account the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR).

The company uses packaging materials and solutions commonly applied in industry, including industrial wooden pallets, pallets specially adapted for particular loads, corrugated cardboard boxes, polyethylene (PE) stretch film, polyethylene terephthalate (PET) strapping and other materials necessary for the protection and transportation of products.

Packaging is selected with consideration for the specific characteristics of the products, load stability, transport safety, efficient use of resources and environmental impact. Industrial and specially adapted pallets are used in accordance with the dimensions, weight and transport requirements of the products.

To the greatest extent reasonably possible, Culimeta Baltics SIA reuses packaging received from its suppliers, including pallets, cardboard boxes and other suitable materials. Packaging is reused only where its technical condition, cleanliness, durability and safety are suitable for further use and where such reuse does not adversely affect product quality or delivery safety.

The purpose of this approach is to reduce the consumption of new packaging materials and the amount of packaging waste generated, extend the useful life of packaging and promote compliance with circular economy principles.

The compliance of packaging materials is supported by material specifications, supplier statements and declarations of conformity available to the company, where such documents are applicable to the relevant type of packaging.

Based on the information and documentation provided by suppliers, the packaging materials used are required to comply with Article 5(4) of the PPWR. The total concentration of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (Cr VI) in packaging or any of its components does not exceed 100 mg/kg.

Where applicable, packaging materials may contain recycled materials, such as post-consumer recycled material in plastic films or recycled fibres in corrugated cardboard.

Culimeta Baltics SIA maintains the documentation available to the company supporting the characteristics and compliance of the packaging materials used. Upon reasonable request, this documentation may be provided to customers or competent authorities, subject to applicable confidentiality requirements.

Where a customer repackages the products or places the packaging on the market under its own name or trademark, the customer assumes the applicable obligations under the PPWR, including extended producer responsibility, registration, reporting and financing obligations.
